To the Cuyahoga County Commissioners, Mayors, City Council Members and Police Chiefs of the Cities of Rocky River, Bay Village, Fairview Park, North Olmsted, and Westlake, and Metroparks

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

As required by §1901.14 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Rocky River Municipal Court herewith submits its Annual Report for 2005. The contents of this report are based on data assembled and tabulated by William E. Gareau, Clerk of Court, and his staff. The following data are noteworthy for the year 2005.

- The total funds received from all sources in the year 2005 amounted to \$6,832,069.46 an increase of \$964,694.08 from 2004.
- 2. The total number of criminal/traffic cases filed in 2005 was 32,825. The statistical breakdown includes 28,515 traffic, 816 DUI/BAC, 2636 misdemeanors, 392 felonies and 466 parking violations. The total criminal/traffic case filings were up 4000 cases from 2004.
- 3. The civil/small claims case filings for 2005 were 2,702. The statistical breakdown includes 2,091 civil, 609 small claims and 2 rent escrow/trusteeship cases. The total civil case filings were up 73 cases over 2004.
- 4. The total amount of court costs disbursed to the City of Rocky River in 2005 from all sources amounted to \$2,979,245.17 an increase of \$212,543.96 from 2004. Of these funds, \$394,462.50 was placed in a special computer fund set up by the Court on January 1, 1996. In addition, \$394,027.00 was placed in a Special Project Fund established by the Court on January 1, 1999. The money in these funds will be used to enhance the Courts computer system and pay off the debt of the new court building. Also, \$102,863.65 was placed in the Courts probation funds. The monies in these special funds are not available for operational costs.

The court experienced a 14% increase in criminal/traffic cases and a 2.75% increase in civil cases during 2005. Civil cases have risen for the past five years. The court has no control over the number of criminal/traffic or civil cases filed each year.

Beginning January 3, 2006, the Clerk's Office is scanning all Criminal/Traffic documents as they are received and/or issued. Civil/Small Claims documents are scanned at the time of filing and then again when the case is closed. At some time in the future, the Supreme Court will authorize electronic record keeping and this procedure will keep Rocky River Municipal Court ahead of the curve. I want to thank the staff of the Clerk's Office for their hard work and dedication during the year. Special thanks are given to Chief Deputy Clerk Deborah Comery who was given responsibility for compiling this report. I would also like to thank Presiding/Administrative Judge Donna Congeni Fitzsimmons and Judge Maureen Adler Gravens, and their staffs for their help and guidance during the year. Finally, appreciation is extended to Rocky River Mayor William Knoble, Rocky River City Council, Police Officers, and Officials of the Rocky River Court District for their assistance.







The Probation Department is a division of Rocky River Municipal Court dedicated to monitoring and rehabilitating offenders of misdemeanor and traffic laws sentenced through the Rocky River Municipal Court system. Our goal is to protect the public and closely monitor these probationers while they are under community control in an attempt to prevent them from re-offending in the future.
