Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

As required by Ohio Revised Code §1901.14, the Annual Report for 2009 is hereby submitted by the Rocky River Municipal Court. The contents of this report are based on data assembled and tabulated by Clerk of Court Deborah F. Comery and Court Staff. The following data is noteworthy for the year 2009:

- 1. The total receipts from all sources in 2009 amounted to \$6,528,705.06 of which \$2,053,087.35 was received for operational expenses. Since 1997, this Court has operated within its operational income.
- 2. There were 23,592 cases filed in criminal/traffic consisting of 19,678 traffic, 581 OVI/BAC, 2,585 misdemeanors, 317 felonies and 431 parking violations. Criminal/traffic case filings were down 1,666 cases from 2008.
- 3. There were 3,887 cases filed in civil and small claims consisting of 2,486 civil, 1,392 small claims and 9 rent escrow/trusteeship cases. The total civil case filings were down 695 cases from 2008.
- 4. The total amount of court costs disbursed to the City of Rocky River from all sources was \$3,111,250.87, a decrease of \$36,344.50 from 2008. Of these monies, \$301,516.10 was placed in the Computer Fund set up by the Court on January 1, 1996, and \$560,164.00 was placed in the Special Projects Fund established by the Court on January 1, 1999. These funds are used to operate and enhance the Court's computer system and continue to pay off the building debt of the Courthouse (occupied in 2003). Also, \$176,678.42 was placed in the Court's Probation Services Fund and \$19,805.00 was placed in the Court's Mediation Fund. The monies in these special funds are not available for operational costs.

The court experienced a 7% decrease in criminal/traffic cases and a 16% decrease in civil/small claims cases during 2009. The court has no control over the number of criminal/traffic or civil/small claims cases filed each year.

The court's website, www.rrcourt.net, continues to grow. E-payments, public records access, weekly court dockets, local court rules, jury service information, probation information, annual reports, and current court costs are among the many items found on our website. Since 2003, the website has accepted E-payments primarily for those defendants who are allowed to waive their traffic ticket. 2009 saw 5,531 transactions, down 576 from 2008. All court documents, both current and historical, continue to be imaged and are available for viewing on the website. E-filing (initially for civil cases only) has been delayed; however, the pilot program will begin in February, 2010. We continue utilizing the E-certified mail process with continuing success. All service information from certified mailings is now downloaded automatically to the case docket. Visitors to a case file can now track, in almost real time, the progress of all E-certified mail pieces as well as view the digital signature of the receiver.

I want to thank the staff of the Clerk's Office for their amazing work and dedication during the year. I would also like to thank Administrative / Presiding Judge Donna Congeni Fitzsimmons and Judge Brian F. Hagan, along with their staffs for their help and guidance during the year. Grateful appreciation is also extended to Rocky River Mayor Pamela E. Bobst, Rocky River City Council, and all the Jurisdictional Police Officers and Officials of the Rocky River Court District for their assistance.







The *Indigent Drivers Alcohol Treatment Fund* provides treatment services for persons arrested while operating a vehicle under the influence. The funds come from fees and fines collected as legislated by the Ohio General Assembly. The Rocky River Municipal Court utilizes these funds to assist OVI offenders who are unable to afford substance abuse treatment.

The *Indigent Drivers Interlock and Alcohol Monitoring Fund* provides for payment of monitoring by Ignition Interlock, SCRAM, EMHA or a Global Tracking System for OVI offenders deemed indigent by the Rocky River Municipal Court. The funds come from fees and fines collected as legislated by the Ohio General Assembly.
